Dear Parents/Carers

In September 2009 started a new programme called 'EVERY CHILD A TALKER' (ECAT). The local education authority has secured funding from the government to deliver this training to 20 settings in the Tameside area. We were very pleased to be selected as one of the settings to benefit from this training programme. The training will be completed over a two year period working with children aged 2-5 years old.

The aims of the programme are:

- To raise children's achievement in early language
- Raise practitioners skills and knowledge
- Increase parental understanding and involvement in children's language development

The outcomes of the training programme are:

- Improved early language development
- Settings to have a Early Language Lead Practitioner
- Increased practitioner knowledge and understanding
- Improved early language development and the quality of language provision/resources
- Increased parental understanding and involvement of parents in their child's language development

We now have a Dictaphone and video recorder to use with the children. The aim is that we will be able to record rhymes and jingles and the communication of your child, with adults and other children in their room. We will then place these in your child's Learning Journey and they will act as an excellent resource for observation of your child's development.

The video would also be used for training purposes by Tameside Early Years Quality Team for other professionals to observe and implement in their settings.

We do require consent from parents to complete these new forms of observation and would be grateful if you could complete the form at the bottom of this letter.
